

Alaska Flyfishing Expeditions Booking Terms & Cancellation Policy

At Alaska Flyfishing Expeditions, each guided trip is carefully planned with dedicated guides, lodging, transportation, and resources reserved specifically for your adventure. Because availability is limited and cancellations are often difficult to fill, the following policy applies to all reservations.

Deposits & Final Payment

- A **50% non-refundable deposit** is required at the time of booking to confirm your reservation.
- The **remaining balance is due 30 days prior** to your scheduled trip.
- Reservations are considered confirmed upon receipt of a deposit, and payment constitutes acceptance of these Booking Terms & Cancellation Policies, whether the reservation is made online, by phone, by email, or in person.

Client Cancellations

- The **50% deposit is non-refundable** under all circumstances.
- Cancellations made **within 30 days** of the scheduled trip are **100% non-refundable**, including any final payments received.
- No refunds will be issued for no-shows, late arrivals, early departures, or unused portions of a trip.

Rescheduling

We understand that plans can change. Guests may request to reschedule their trip under the following conditions:

- Rescheduling is permitted **one time only**, subject to availability and management approval.
- Requests must be made **more than 30 days prior** to the scheduled trip to avoid forfeiting the reservation.
- Rescheduled trips are subject to current seasonal pricing. If rescheduled for a future season, the reservation will be adjusted to the published rates for that season.
- The remaining balance for a rescheduled trip must be paid no later than **90 days before** the new trip date.

Weather & River Conditions

The safety of our guests and guides is our highest priority.

If Alaska Flyfishing Expeditions determines that weather, river conditions, or other circumstances make it unsafe to operate a scheduled trip, we reserve the right to postpone or cancel the trip.

In these situations:

- Payments made will be applied as a credit toward a future trip.
- Refunds will not be issued for cancellations made by Alaska Flyfishing Expeditions due to unsafe conditions beyond our control.

Force Majeure

Alaska Flyfishing Expeditions is not responsible for delays, interruptions, or cancellations resulting from circumstances beyond our reasonable control, including but not limited to severe weather, flooding, wildfires, natural disasters, airline disruptions, government actions, military orders, labor disputes, public health emergencies, or other force majeure events.

When possible, we will work with guests to reschedule their trip; however, refunds are not guaranteed under these circumstances.

Reservation Holder Responsibility

The individual making the reservation is responsible for all payments and for communicating these policies to every member of their party.

Travel Insurance

We strongly recommend purchasing travel insurance that includes coverage for trip cancellation, trip interruption, medical emergencies, emergency evacuation, and travel delays. Travel insurance can help protect your investment should unforeseen circumstances prevent you from traveling.

Our Commitment

We understand that unexpected situations arise and will always do our best to work with our guests whenever possible. If we are able to rebook your reservation, Alaska Flyfishing Expeditions may, at its sole discretion, apply payments toward a future trip or provide a partial credit, less any costs incurred. Any exceptions to this policy are made solely at the discretion of Alaska Flyfishing Expeditions and do not establish a precedent for future reservations.
